CONSULTANTS

CLINICAL OR PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE

ICSA employs contractors on a retainer where applicable, specialist areas of practice or expertise are then called on when needed at mutually agreed rates and conditions.

AGREEMENTS

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANTING

ICSA will enter MOUs with community & welfare organisations or private enterprise for a **formal collaboration**. Such AGREEMENTS are formed to deliver on specific projects or working parties.

PARTNERSHIPS

ICSA will form partnerships with other organisations where a contractual relationship is necessary to clarify roles, relationships, responsibilities and financial arrangements.
